## General behavior on the track

Even though Valencia is considered a tough track with some really tough races and/or battles, the general behavior on the track was pretty good this time by. With fewer incidents reported than the last round. We are pleased with the response to previous warnings and are seeing obvious signs of cleaner but competitive driving. But we will continue to monitor this aspect closely to maintain the desired driving standards.

### GROUP 1

#### RACE 1

174 sec: Cristian Haba / Rami Kaukkola: No penalty. Just a minor bump /paint swapping. It was just racing & nobody got affected by it.

180 sec: Peter Böszörményi: Warning to Peter Böszörményi

181 sec: Stirb Iuliu cutting: No penalty. It was not a cutting, but merely lost a bit control of the car while braking & turning for T10.

286 sec: Raymond Tsang / Anthony Martin: No penalty. Racing incident.

570-585 sec: Oliver Wickens / Stirb Iuliu: No penalty. It is just the result hard racing each other.

#### RACE 2

167 sec: Gregory Degreef / Mikael Larsson.: No penalty. Although we like to advice both drivers take a bit more attention to their surroundings & opponents.

169 sec: Oliver Wickens / Jari Vinnari: 10 sec penalty to Oliver Wickens.

192 sec: Marcin Skrypczak / Oliver Wickens: No Penalty. But Marcin should take it more carefull braking into the Audi corner, especially considering it's only lap 1 at the moment (cold tires & brakes).

196-199 sec: Oliver Wickens / Anthony Martin: No penalty.

223 sec: Peter Eriksson / Geofredo Rosario: No penalty. It was hard racing against eachother.

239 sec: Geofredo Rosario / Peter Eriksson: No Penalty. But we like to advice both drivers to give a bit more room or be more careful to each other.

669 sec: Marcin Skrypczak / Mikael Larsson: No penalty. Only paint swapping.

1412 sec: Oliver Wickens / Mikael Larsson: No penalty. Racing incident & Oliver waited nicely to let Mikael pass him to regain his position.

1468 sec: Sol Leung / Mikael Larsson: No penalty. Although we like to point out to both drivers be a bit more aware of their surroundings on the track.

### GROUP 2

#### RACE 1

154-171 sec: Foxs Yiu / Gary Lennon: warning for Foxs, dangerous driving

750 sec Jims Bong / Niklas Hjelm: no penalty, both drivers could have take more care for the other, Niklas on the corner entry and Jims on the exit after

1220 sec: Helder Assuncao / Gary Lennon: 20 points penalty and DQ for next round for Helder. Intentionally and deliberately ramming off Gary, not even trying to make the corner, the only aim is to hit the car infront, unacceptable behaviour. Next unsportmanship move from Helder will result DQ from the whole League.

### GROUP 3

#### QUALIFY

1724-1735 sec: Michael K Christensen / Jamie Wilson: Michael intentionally holding up Jamie during qualification, overtaking and blocking him in his flying lap just to disturb him to improve his time. 20 points penalty to Michael and general warning, next intentional unfair move will result in exclusion from the whole League.

### GROUP 4

#### RACE 1

116 sec: Raino Priha / Frederic Dubios: Warning to Raino Priha for braking to late into T1 on lap 1 (on cold brakes & tires).

\*) 118 sec: Alvaro Mourato / Nils Wijk: Penalty to Alvaro Mourato for late braking into T1 on lap 1 (on cold brakes & tires).

120 sec: Fernando De Almeida / Terry Harmer: No Penalty. Racing incident.

158 sec: Warning to Robert Graunert for entering the track dangerously.

257 sec: Adriano Esanto / Sergio Jorge: No Penalty. Racing incident. But Sergio should watch his mirrors better.

268 sec: Sergio Jorge / Karl Westman: Warning to Sergio Jorge for entering the track dangerously.

#### RACE 2

129 sec Adriano Esanto / Frederic Dubios: Warning to Adriano Esanto for braking to late into T1 on lap 1 (on cold brakes & tires).

\*) 130 sec Alvaro Mourato / Bo Sorensen: Penalty for Alvaro.

1324 sec Alvaro Mourato / Jacek Kozlowski: No penalty. Racing Incident.

\*) Because Alvaro Mourato already received a penalty for such incidents before, for this time Alvaro will get **10 points deduction** as a penalty. The next time Alvaro make such a move again, he will be disqualified for the next round.

### Further Race Director Rulings

Stephen Rogers: Used a default skin. Due to the number of issues with custom skins not showing, and because it had no impact on race results, no penalties imposed this time. However, the reported driver is warned to comply with the regulations regarding skins, and if your custom skin is not available, then you must select the single drivers skin. Further breaches will result in penalties for future races.

## Non-Reported Absences:

As advised in the League Rules and regulations, this is a serious issue since it prevents other drivers from gaining spots in the League Rounds. All competitors were also given a final warning via the Forum. The following drivers were pre-qualified for Valencia, but did not race and did not submit absence reports via the correct email method before the pre-qualification for Rounds 4 was opened. Therefore, the following drivers are excluded from pre-qualification for Round 4 at Brno.

## Absence

If you can't make it to the race, while you did set a lap time in pre-qualification, you must **report your absence**. You can do this by sending an e-mail to [absences@racedepartment.com](mailto:absences@racedepartment.com). Don't forget to add your name and start number in the "subject" of the e-mail: WTCC - [name] - [start#]. You must do this at least 24 hours before the start of the race!

If, for some valid and uncontrollable circumstance, you were not able to race, you can report the absence after the event. Please do this personally, via the requested email address, as soon as possible but no later than the start of Pre-Qualification for the next rounds.

## Incidents

Incident reports are being sent that do not include all of the needed information requested. This makes it very difficult for Race Directors.

If you have encountered a driver breaking the rules or making questionable manoeuvres, you can contact the Race Direction to let them investigate the matter. You must however make sure you have **checked the replay** of the incident before you report anything. Reports can be sent **between 3 and 48 hours after the race**. Please make sure you also add the names of the involved drivers, their start numbers, the time of the incident (in replay seconds) and a short description of the incident.
